

New Vision Wilderness YOQ Results

Y-OQ 2.0 results from New Vision Wilderness Quest program participants in 2011, demonstrated an average initial score of 74 during admission and an average score of 45.44 upon their discharge. The Y-OQ Reliability Change Index (RCI), provides the amount by which a client's total score must increase (deterioration) or decrease (improvement) to be considered clinically significant. Changes in the total score that are less than the RCI are not statistically relevant. In order to be clinically significant Y-OQ results for the Y-OQ 2.0 assessment must be 18 points or above. NVW Y-OQ results show a point decrease of 28.56, indicating that on average NVW Quest clients are demonstrating clinically significant improvement after participation.
